MOTION #2: Out of Incarcerated Veterans Committee. Move to change the name of the Incarcerated Veterans Committee to the Veterans in the Justice System Committee. (No second required) – **Passed**

COMMITTEE REPORT UPDATES CONTINUED:

- Incorporation Committee reports that there are 2 chapters in the process, and 1 more who has requested the information packet. The committee is working with one state to avoid dissolution.
- Leadership Committee is starting the planning of the VVA Education and Leadership Conference for the summer of 2016.
- P&P Committee requested input on the concept of adding a table of contents to the policy manual. Several ideas were offered on how we



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- can make specific information easier to find. The committee chair will try out some of these ideas and test them over the next few weeks.
- Public and Media Affairs requested that the regional directors provide the names of the major newspapers in the local areas of their chapters. Also asked for any information that the regional directors can gather on businesses that set up billboards in their regions.
- Vista Program Committee reports that there are significantly more hours that have been reported since the October 5th report.
- Strategic Planning Committee reminds the board members and other committee chairs to go back over the Strategic Plan, and notify the committee of any goals that have been met, or that need changes or updates.

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MOTION #9: Strike the proposed first paragraph (pertaining to motion #10) and accept the remainder of the changes requested in P&P Section 1 regarding language required by the newly adopted bylaws, and various changes in job duties and requirements. - **Passed as amended**

POLICY AND PROCEDURE CHANGES CONTINUED:

MOTION #10: Motion out of Michigan to add language to section 1.XIII that would state that the AVVA state president, or representative would be the official ambassador of AVVA to other organizations. **Motion withdrawn by submitting party.**

MOTION #11: Motion out of Finance Committee to add/change language that will clarify sanctions for board members who do not file the proper after action and/or special advisor reports. – **Passed**

MOTION #12: Motion out of Elections Committee to delete the paragraph from section 5 that allows for absentee ballots <u>in a state election</u>. - **Passed**

MOTION #13: Motion out of P&P committee to add deputy regional directors to section 5.II.A, and 5.II.A.1. - **Passed**

MOTION #14: Motion by member Pat Furno to add language to section 6.XI, between the current f and g, that would require the board to notify state presidents, reps, and POCs about any policy changes 20 days prior to such change, so that they would have an opportunity to modify or object. - **Failed**

MOTION #15: Motion out of P&P Committee to revise the required information for the National Information Distribution List (6.X.B.1-6), the language regarding use of letterhead (6.V) and to add a new sub-section regarding political activities (6.XIII) – **Passed as amended**

MOTION #16: Motion by member Betty Pike, seconded by R5 director Cecilia Essenmacher, to change the language in section 7.I.J.3.b so that that



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permanently hospitalized Veterans could be either at-large or in a specific chapter. - *Failed*

MOTION #17: Motion out of Veterans' Benefits Committee to add new #5 to section VI.A of the AVVA Service Officer Policy, which will allow for the program chair to recommend a complimentary life membership to service officers who have met the criteria. (Criteria will be added to the policy). - **Passed**

MOTION #18: Motion out of P&P Committee to modify section 3 to reflect the changes in name and/or status of the AVVA committees. - **Passed**

MOTION #19: Motion by the Secondary PTSD Program co-chairs to add the new program to section 8 of the P&P, with the program overview as submitted. - **Passed**

MOTION #20: Motion by Cathy Keister, second by Nancy Rekowski, to rescind the motion dated October 4, 2012, which provided A.O. pins to the state of Michigan at no cost to MI. – **Passed**

MOTION #21: Motion by Cathy Keister, second by Elayne Mackey, to rescind the motion dated April 12, 2003, which required AVVA to provide cell phones or funding toward cell phones for the national officers. - **Passed**

GENERAL ORDERS:

Update on NFVF: Elaine Simmons has resigned from the board of directors of the foundation. Two persons have been added to that board: Linda Yates and Sandra Allen (new secretary).

Vendor Update: The links for vendor Ideal Images have been added to our website and are functioning.

In-Memory Plaque Project Update: We are at the end of the design process with a final design very close. Funding for this step in the project has been exhausted. The task force is requesting that the board allow for additional funds to at least get through the design process, which should allow us to begin fundraising specifically for this project.
