VVA PUBLIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

- Discussed the ROTC program as a way to approach our young people in our High Schools.
- I brought up the Veterans History Project a Part of the Library of Congress to approach High School, Universities, Corporations, Businesses, All Veterans Organizations, All Associate Veteran Organizations and Others. This idea was received favorably by the Public Affairs Committee and Mokie Stated that this was an outstanding program that had great potential for VVA Public Affairs and for Veterans in general.

VVA GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

 Blood Pressure Study lin between service-related occupational exposure to herbicides and high blood pressure (hypertension) risk among U.S. Army Chemical Corps. (ACC) Veterans, a group of Veterans assigned to do chemical operations during the Vietnam War. Researchers also found an association between military service in Vietnam and hypertension risk among these Veterans.

- Caregiver bill needs your attention. Grassroots effort needed to access VA caregiving stipend. As it stands now, Veterans must be totally incapacitated to receive stipend from VA.
- Gold Star trying to change the requirements to include any Veteran death during any service. Would dilute the Gold Star for combat related deaths.
