PURPOSE: The AVVA Fellowship Award is an honor bestowed upon an active regular AVVA member who has exhibited outstanding service to our veterans, the AVVA and their local community during the applicable year.

It is also possible to nominate an individual within the community who has provided philanthropic and significant service to the veterans and/or the community.

WHO CAN MAKE A NOMINATION? Any current AVVA or VVA member can make the nomination.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD NOMINATION:

- Regular AVVA member in good standing (no disciplinary actions) OR a qualified community member.
- Actions that represent outstanding service to the AVVA, their chapter or state.
- Nominee's commitment to the mission and vision of AVVA.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

- Complete F-AWA03.03 and forward to Awards Committee (address on form.)
- Evidence of nominee's efforts and successes:
 - Outstanding service to veterans, AVVA & their community; initiation of programs; planning of successful local & veterans' events; a leader who inspires others.
- Nominee's service in the local community reflecting their participation in significant events, locally, statewide and/or national level.
- Notable accomplishments (include any media recognition, newspaper articles, letters of appreciation, etc.
- Tenure as an AVVA member including AVVA positions held (elected and appointed).

NOMINATIONS MUST BE BASED ON ACCOMPLISHMENTS MADE DURING THE CURRENT EVENT YEAR (PREVIOUS MONTH OF MAY TO CURRENT MONTH OF MAY).

NOMINATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO ADDRESS ON FORM NO LATER THAN MAY 31 OF APPLICABLE YEAR.

No self-nominations. Current national board members are not eligible.
